- In FA16, a total of 362 courses were represented in the EWP submissions; FA17 shows a decrease of 17 courses from which students chose to submit.
- In FA16, 860 submissions of the 1849 total submissions came from WI/WC courses (46% of the submissions for the semester); this percentage shows a decrease from the previous FA15 semester in WI/WC submissions. In FA17, 818 of the total submissions came from WI/WC courses (49% of total), which shows a 3% increase from the previous year as well as a 1% increase from FA15.
- Only one submission was received from 110 courses. The most submissions came from ENG 1001G with 72 submissions followed by ENG 1002G with 42 submissions and EDF 2555G and BUS 3200 each with 29 submissions. A total of 141 submissions were received from the senior seminar courses.
