NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION MONTH

The month of September is National Suicide Prevention Month. Suicide is a leading cause of death for all ages in the United states and substance use is a risk factor (Esang & Ahmed, 2018). Esang and Ahmed (2018) stated that "Compared with the general population, individuals with alcohol dependence and persons who use drugs have a 10-14 times greater risk of death by suicide, respectively." Additionally, of deaths by suicide, 22% including alcohol intoxication, 20% had opiates present, 10.2% had marijuana present, 4.6% had cocaine present, and 3.4% had amphetamines (Esang & Ahmed, 2018). This highlights the importance of alcohol and other drug use prevention efforts. Drinking at an early age and binge or heavy drinking are only 2 factors that can lead to increased suicidal ideation (Esang & Ahmed, 2018).
