Successful completion of the master's degree from an ASHA CAA accredited program such as EIU, passing the national Praxis Speech-Language Pathology exam (SLP praxis exam is administered by ETS <https://www.ets.org/praxis/asha>), and successful completion of a clinical fellowship year prepares students from any US state or territory for ASHA certification and state professional licensure. Some states require a separate educator license to work as an SLP in the school setting (see other document).
